

# OXFORD AQA INTERNATIONAL GCSE ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

## Paper 4 Speaking

Time allowed: 10 minutes (+ supervised preparation time of 10 minutes).

The test will consist of two parts:

**Part 1 Photo card (15 marks)**  
Approximately 3-4 minutes

**Part 2 General conversation (25 marks)**  
Approximately 6-7 minutes

### Instructions

- During the preparation time candidates are required to prepare one Photo card.
- Candidates may make notes during the preparation time for use during the test. They must hand these notes to you before the General Conversation.
- Candidates should hand the Photo card to you before the General Conversation.

### Information

- The test will last a maximum of 10 minutes and will consist of a Photo card followed by a General Conversation. The Photo card and the General Conversation are based on all themes.
- Candidates must not use a dictionary at any time during this test. This includes the preparation time. Each candidate should cover one theme in the Photo card. The General Conversation themes should cover the two remaining themes not covered by the candidate in the Photo card.

**Theme 1 Card A Photo card**

- Look at the photo during the preparation period.
- Make any notes you wish to on an Additional Answer Sheet.
- Your teacher will then ask you questions about the photo and about topics related to **Me, my family and friends.**



Your teacher will ask you the following three questions:

- What can you see in the photo?
- Who are the people in your family?
- Do you spend your free time with family or with friends?

**Theme 1 Card B Photo card**

- Look at the photo during the preparation period.
- Make any notes you wish to on an Additional Answer Sheet.
- Your teacher will then ask you questions about the photo and about topics related to **Technology in everyday life.**



Your teacher will ask you the following three questions:

- What can you see in the photo?
- When did you last use a computer?
- What do you think about social network sites?
