Depth study B: Germany, 1918–45

- 3 (a) Write an account of the events in 1932–33 that led to Hitler's appointment as Chancellor. [15]
- (b) Discuss the importance of Hitler's leadership of the Nazi Party to its electoral success by 1932. [25]
- 4 (a) Write an account of the methods developed by the Nazis to control the German people. [15]
- (b) Discuss the importance of the Gestapo in Nazi Germany. [25]

Depth study C: Russia, 1905–41

- 5 (a) Write an account of the collapse of the Tsarist regime in 1917. [15]
- (b) Discuss the impact on Russia in early 1917 of economic problems. [25]
- 6 (a) Write an account of how Stalin controlled the Soviet people. [15]
- (b) Discuss the importance for the Soviet Union of Stalin's modernisation of agriculture. [25]

Depth study D: The United States, 1919–41

- 7 (a) Write an account of the problems faced in the textile industry in the 1920s. [15]
- (b) Discuss the impact of the end of the First World War on the American economy. [25]
- 8 (a) Write an account of Roosevelt's 'Hundred Days'. [15]
- (b) Discuss the impact of the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA). [25]
