- 1** Historians differ in their judgements about Russia's economic development in the years 1891–1903.

'The most significant feature of Russia's economic development, in the years 1891–1903, was the growth of railways.'

Assess this view using your own knowledge of the issue.

- 2** Historians have different explanations for the survival of Tsarist rule in the years 1903–14.

'In the years 1903–14, the use of repression rather than political reform was the main reason Tsarist rule survived.'

Assess this view using your own knowledge of the issue.

(Total for Question 2 = 25 marks)

OR

- 3** Historians differ in their judgements about the weakening of Romanov rule.

'In the years 1914–17, the role of the Empress Alexandra was more significant than the decisions made by Tsar Nicholas II in the weakening of Romanov rule.'

Assess this view using your own knowledge of the issue.

(Total for Question 3 = 25 marks)

- 4** Historians have different explanations for the Bolshevik seizure of power in 1917.

'The main reason why the Bolsheviks were able to seize power in October 1917 was the role of Lenin.'
